Alexandra's poems with designs all start from one main theme, which creates its own harmonic ripples as it unravels. The initial theme, melodic and rhythmic, verse and visual, contains the sprouting buds of the entire symphony. Hence, the opening pages of each poem set forth a hypnotising, escalating momentum. The way in which her message expands in each book is similar to a harmonious musical synthesis with vibrant hues. The poem and graphics are amplified in an intensifying pattern and each crescendo culminates in an "inner flight". Her poetic and illustrative patterns have many personal and universal values, which create the basic source of vibrations from which more vibrations are set in motion, like the butterfly effect in the theory of chaos.
